

They easily recognizable in multi-dimensions of our society including church, government, education, news and entertainment. Lo, Baal has again established in the minds of men desires to "have things as I want them," while the idea "the good of all" is hacked from our conscience. Thus, our new age is just a repeat of the old age of idol worship.

INTRODUCTION

If you are looking for a book to enjoy reading, this is definitely not for you. If you are seeking a closer relationship with others including God himself, then this writing has possibilities. If you have committed to finding your place in the field of God's Kingdom on earth, then fasten your seat belt. The Spiritual Revolution 2018 is for you! Let's start our journey by re-thinking some basics— that is to say, look at a familiar setting from a different place in the room.

Consider the Bible as progression of relationship, an accurate historical account of the ever-deepening relationship between God and man. Whereby, knowledge of God was initially given through Abraham, Joseph of Egypt, King David, the prophet Ezekiel and others. The actions of these men in the Old Testament both demonstrated and taught obedience to their Creator. Next, man was given personal access to God through the New Covenant integrating redemption through Jesus Christ and the urging of the Holy Spirit. Now comes the final revelation, pressing forward the Kingdom Age that will operate with Righteous Fire, awesomely consuming sin and empowering Believers.

Genesis tells of mankind's divine creation and his struggle with evil. In the 17th Chapter God makes Covenant with Abraham and his descendants. A type of covenant whereby, the weaker partner freely submits in obedience to serve the stronger partner, while the stronger partner provides resources and protection that the weaker cannot provide for himself. This Abrahamic Covenant has remained in effect for 4,000 years.

However, "free will" and mischievousness of mankind inevitably leads to disobedience. No one in the Old Testament was able to stay in obedience, and all succumb to condemnation under the Law. Even ritual sacrifice could not sustain them. This is why ministers who emphasize in the Old Testament to the exclusion of the covering of the New Covenant, unknowingly condemn their congregation to failure.

Foretold in ancient Scripture and announced in Gospel of the New Testament, God gave His Son as a "perfect" sacrifice for the forgiveness of sin. Jesus demonstrated through His life, death and resurrection the love of our Creator. Furthermore, the same

Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead, has been made available to those who believe. Such that, we may not only have eternal life in heaven, but life more abundantly through direct access to the Father and provision of the Holy Spirit.

In His final teachings to His disciples: “Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes to the Father, but by me (John 14:6) ... Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father (John 14:12) ... However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He (the Holy Spirit) will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. (John 16:13-14).”

It is most unfortunate indeed that the Church has been timid spiritually and distracted by religious spirits such that the actualization of these teachings has not been accomplished to a significant degree. A precious few individual Believers and brief encounters of revival have hinted at what is to come.

The revolution begins with a wakeup call. Once we have the vision, church cannot continue as usual. Our plans are disrupted, but our prayer comes alive: "Thy Kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth..."

While the Spiritual Revolution involves repentance, it is not a condemnation. Rather, it is the mission to bring the Kingdom on earth.

CHURCH GONE WRONG

We are brought to Salvation (righteous relationship with God the Father) by faith in our redemption through Jesus Christ (the Son) and the leading of the Holy Spirit. The depth of our relationship with God should continually increase, however, there are only two ultimate states. These are characterized by (1) an intimate relationship with the God ever growing in faithfulness and trust; or (2) holding on to self-willed control of our lives and trying to justify disobedience.

Church has falsely lead people to think that affirming a knowledge of God will do. Salvation is a spiritual state not an intellectual one. It is entered by grace and maintained by faith demonstrated by obedience and fruit bearing.



The term “saved” suggests a single event, similar to saying my friend saved me from drowning, but that does not address “saved” for what? Such an event in the secular world, should result in a lifelong gratitude and the expectation of an attitude of wanting to demonstrate appreciation. If God offers righteousness and eternal life through the sacrifice of His Son, should we not be trusting and faithful and submit unto Him?

Members of the mob, the so called wise guys, may affirm a knowledge of God, but they continue in criminal behavior. They think they have a guaranteed pass, without comprehending repentance nor judgment. The arrogant, rebellious and selfish churchgoers must also repent to enter the Kingdom. Neither shall the un-repentant church busybody, or those who structured their own self-serving image of God, enter in.

Though faith driven evangelic Christians thrive in intimate relationship with their Creator, cultural and congregational Christians don't realize that there is nothing in between the two states - intimate relationship & eternal separation. Thus, people have been deceived in believing that cultural identification and affiliation qualify them for eternal life.

State of Christianity in America

The internal state may be some what subjective and ambiguous in our minds (but not in the judgment of God). However, the exterior facts are clear. Based in creditable surveys, this is the State of Salvation in America:

About 75% of American people believe that by having a cultural identification with Christianity or their church affiliation, they have submitted their lives unto the Lord and qualify for heaven. Obviously, they fail to realize that even demons have knowledge of Christianity, and that mere reasoning or affiliation is grossly insufficient prerequisite for transformation. Of the 20% of Americans who attend church claim salvation without regard to the Scriptural admonition: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom..."

According to the United States Census Bureau Records and supporting reports:

- Every year more than 4000 churches close their doors compared to just over 1000 new church starts!
- Every year, 2.7 million church members fall into inactivity. This translates into the realization that people are leaving the church. From our research, we have found that they are leaving as hurting and wounded victims-of some kind of abuse, disillusionment, or just plain neglect!
- From 1990 to 2000, the combined membership of all Protestant denominations in the USA declined by almost 5 million members (9.5 percent), while the US population increased by 24 million (11 percent).
- At the turn of the last century (1900), there was a ratio of 27 churches per 10,000 people, as compared to the close of this century (2000) where we have 11 churches per 10,000 people in America!

It is a tragedy that many people who only embrace Christianity intellectually are hindered in their recognition of depth and simplicity of following Jesus.

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!' " - Mathew 7:21-23

in regard to fruit bearing

"Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.'

"Then they also will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?' Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, in as much as you did not do it to one

of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." - Mathew 25:41-46

It is not our rigidity to rules that wins favor with God, but it is the intimacy and integrity of our relationship with Him. A deeper resolve to put away sin or studying to acquire Biblical knowledge will profit little in comparison to seeking a deeper relationship with God the Father. For us to change our nature is most difficult, but we can be marvelously transformed through intimate relationship. The heading over that entry way is "Worship."



Failures of Church

Churches in America, today, too often resemble elite airport lounges that cater to the comfort and prestige of their members, while they await departure. Such churches operate more like clubs interested in pacifying its members, than preparing an army to overcome evil and rescue the lost.

For those who need a wake-up call to the distressing news: The church is failing in every category except maybe social grace and correctness. These clubs are actually fust budgets, who think they are monuments to God with nice programs, beautiful settings and finances focused on its personnel and buildings.

Internally, church-goers have same divorce rate as the world. They have the same problems of emotional distress, family dysfunction and lack. This should not be a surprise since most church-goers have never understood or actualized "deliver us from evil" – i.e. from the iniquity in their hearts and self-serving idols designed to suit their personal kingdom. Thus, church-goers, in general, remain captives.

Externally, the symptoms of decay are worse. Despite the directive to reach out to a lost world, most church-goers have never not been a party to actually leading even one person into the Kingdom. Many churches have little or no funds for missions or

evangelism, instead they are devoted to paying for their monument to God and its caretakers.

Here are 10 Non-Performance Issues of the Church

- Church-goers do not want their comfort zone disturbed by being aware of an enemy that seeks to kill, steal and destroy – as long as it is not me or mine
- Condemnation or complacency can rob Believers of their destiny
- Church-goers want to justify themselves rather than face repentance from sin
- Believers are greatly weakened by not tearing down their idols in their lives
- Many church-goers believe in gloom and doom as much as they do in victory
- There is a lack of knowledge of the role of Worship
- Not understanding, light never runs from darkness makes victims not warriors
- Demonic control of church and its guardians is open for Satan, when even the clergy are ill equipped for spiritual warfare
- Not recognizing that the “Second Coming is NOT Judgment Day” makes for errant theology
- Ignorance of the most powerful force, the Holy Spirit, is rampant. Casualties lay in ditches on both sides of the road with “not for today” and “name it and claim it” notions

STUMBLING BLOCKS

Falsehood of Pride

The Worship of Self & Ours

The Bible says God resists the proud and describes pride as being at the root of all sin. Therefore, we should humble ourselves or God will do it for us. James 4:6 says it well, “God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble.”

The most tragic part of being deceived that pride is good, is that it serves as an easy entry point for work of demons and is the pre-cursor to idolatry.

Pastor [Jack Wellman](#) writes:

The world operates from a sense of pride. This is what the Apostle John wrote in 1st John 2:16 “*For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world*” which is exactly what happened to Satan and caused the fall of Adam and Eve in the Garden. The way of Edom is the way that most of the world operates as Obadiah writes “*The pride of your heart has deceived you, you who live in the clefts of the rocks and make your home on the heights, you who say to yourself, ‘Who can bring me down to the ground’*” (Obad 1:3) so pride can deceive us. The same thing happened to King Belshazzar “*when his heart became arrogant and hardened with pride, he was deposed from his royal throne and stripped of his glory*” (Dan 5:20).

Neglect of the Most Powerful Force in the Universe

To paraphrase [Francis Chan](#): We make our declaration the name of the Father, the Son, and ... the Holy Spirit. But how often do we live with an awareness of only the first two? As Jesus ascended into heaven, He promised to send the Holy Spirit so that we could be true and living witnesses for Christ. Unfortunately, today's church has admired the gift but neglected to open it.

The power of the Holy Spirit is more than enough, but most Believers know almost nothing about Him. John G. Lake, who had 100,000 documented miracle healings said;

“It is the conscious presence of the of the living, risen Son of God dwelling in our heart by the Holy Spirit, which causes you and I to know that the power of God is equal to every emergency and is great enough for the deliverance of every soul from every oppression.”

“The Holy Ghost in the Christian was to be as powerful as the Holy Ghost was in the Christ.”

Failure to Recognize the Enemy

Idols & Demons



Scripture tells us that we wrestle not with flesh and blood (humans) but with powers of darkness (Ephesians 6:12).

Demons are the infantry of the evil principalities who are sent to harm

humanity in general and keep Believers from their destiny. If people are not aware of their influence, their job is much easier.

Idols (gods) are man-made entities (physical or notions) which have been placed on a level of worship. Such worship opens the heart to iniquity and stronger influence by demons. This is demonstrated in how some people seek wealth or vicariously participate in sporting events. The root idolatry is always in the desire to please themselves, to have things as person wants and to have control. This is done without regard for respect for others or the authority of God and leads to destruction.

Simple examples of Idolatry: The desire to have wealth can become so strong, a person is willing to kill another to steal wealth. Or, a man is so engrossed in his obsession with sports, an alcoholic high or other self-gratification that he neglects his role as a father.

The duo, [Jezebel and Ahab](#), that ruled ancient Israel were the personification of idols and demons in action. A marriage of political alliance between this King of Israel and a Phoenician princess, Jezebel, that was touted to lead the Hebrew into a new age. This began with the worship of Baal, cast as the god of self-fulfillment but actually was to the detriment of all things good.



The worship of Baal led to the hideous practice of sacrificing children (a practice in our modern world called abortion) to Moloch, an idol that called for destroying babies for promise of a better future of the parents. Disgracing that once the bond of love between parent and child has been broken, in whatever manner, evil replaces the goodness in a family and then spreads like a cancer through generations.

The church has, for the most part, dismissed demons and idols as unimportant and out of date with modern thinking. Somehow, they have wrongly concluded that Jesus and the writers of Scripture didn't know what they were talking. Idols of our forefathers and idols our own making coupled with unrecognized & unrestrained demonic influences severely limit our ability to usher in the GLORY of God's Kingdom on earth.

Consider the following quote:

I start with my own story, and the stories of many others like me. I'm an evangelical and have a high view of the Bible—I have a PhD in biblical studies at King's College London, which will be my third theology degree—and I know both the ancient languages and also the state of scholarly research. Yet, after much prayerful study, I've discovered the liberating truth that it's possible to be an idolatrous Christian. That, at least, is evidence that you can be an evangelical and an idolater.

Every Believer should be accountable, first seeking to unmask the Idols and demons in their own life and overcome them. This is greatly hampered by the disbelief that demons or idols exist, and even so, naive that they might have power over Christians.

Fortunately, there are now Kingdom Warriors growing strong in spirit to rise up and take on this evil in the world.

GLORIOUS VICTORY

Overcoming Our Weaknesses

The first challenge is to repent, not unlike that of John the Baptist's call, "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand." John was speaking of the Messiah, Jesus in the flesh. Now, the Kingdom Age is now at hand; no time to be bound by sin. Let us be honest to God and admit our wrongs and change our ways. Note: Saying "I'm sorry" is not repentance. Many offenders are sorry, but few are repentant.

Repentance is a process that take us out of sin, over pride and into forgiveness.



Jesus did the hard work, taking on our sin and dying that we might choose salvation. The Spirit convicts us to be honest with God and urges us to become free from the law of sin and death. Though, the work has been done, and the motivation to be free is attractive, pride will justify ourselves to remain in sin.

So, what is required of us? We Believers have to leap over the pit of pride by confessing our sin, asking to receive forgiveness and committing to righteousness. Then, and only then, as we forgive others we become forgiven. "...[Forgive](#) our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us (Matthew 6:12)."

Caution: while God is merciful to those who turn from wickedness, there is “no forgiveness” for arrogance, stiff-necked and unforgiving. The clever saying, “It is easier to get forgiveness than it is to get permission,” is a false. We have permission to act in our own free will, but sin always has torment.

The Holy Spirit

He exalts Jesus, convicts us, regenerates us, lives in us, guides us, prompts us to worship, and more. The Holy Spirit empowers committed Believers to bring forth God's glory. The Holy Spirit is the ultimate resource for truth and power. However, much of His work is dependent on our partnership. Thereby, those led by the Spirit will demonstrate evidence of the fruit of the Spirit in their attitude, purpose and activity.

Gifts of the Spirit are specific manifestation of the Holy Spirit that are embedded within a Believer, whether realized, matured and used or not. These are described in 1 Corinthians 12 as the word of wisdom (understanding), the word of knowledge (factual info), faith (sensing, speaking and work in agreement with God), (diverse) gifts of healing, miracles (supernatural manifestations), discerning of spirits (recognizing specifics of good and evil), prophecy (presenting what one hears God speak), tongues (both unknown and spiritual language), and interpretation of tongues (translation).

The [Role of the Holy Spirit](#) and the utilization of Its gifts are unfortunately a source of confusion and contradiction within churches. One extreme disavows the manifestations as “not for today,” primarily because of errant theology and failure to see the gifts perform on demand.

The other extreme saying all things are possible with God means I can name and claim anything by faith, and the Lord is obligated to fulfill my proclamation - no matter how unsound and uninformed as to His will. They would do well emphasize wisdom and discernment before trying to leap into faith (faith being also a fruit of the Spirit that manifests with maturity).

Balance comes from partnership with Holy Spirit. This is developed in the presentation of "Righteous Fire."

KINGDOM AGE STRATEGY

There is a danger in dwelling in the Old Testament without the covering of New Covenant. However, the Old Testament teaches us the history of God and man's relationship. Its stories of defeat show consequences of wrong, and its triumphs are exalting, paradigms of spiritual warfare.

Measured by Angels

Abraham, highly favored by the Lord, was visited by angelic beings, who looked like men. Two visited the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah and observed the wickedness there. The other (considered to be the Lord) stayed with Abraham.

Being told that these cities were going to be destroyed because of their wickedness, Abraham plead for the people to be spared. The Lord agreed to that if 50 righteous people lived there, their cities would be spared. Finally, the number of righteous was reduced to 10, but to no avail.

The two Angels arrived at Lot's (nephew of Abraham) house as was under Lot's protection as was there customs. However, the men of the city surrounded Lot's house, asking that the two be with them sexually. Lot even offered his two virgin daughters as an alternative.

The two Angels escorted Lot and his family out of the city, as the fire from heaven destroyed the cities including people, building and vegetation. Lot's wife, disobeying the admonition not to look back, was turned to a pillar of salt.

First came a warning that the wickedness of Sodom and Gomorrah would not be tolerated any longer; the manifestation of Angels was evidence of the seriousness. Subtler was the opportunity to stay the execution. The Lord was no bargaining with Lot. Rather, He was agreeing that 10 righteous men could lead these cities to repentance and avoid destruction – unfortunately there were none other Lot and his family.

American is similarly being measured. But, be encourage that a few righteous Believers, committed to the task, can turn our nation around.

Elijah's Fire

God's intention for His Kingdom manifested strong in the Prophet Elijah. Speaking for God to the people of ancient Israel, Elijah urged them to turn from idol worship and to return to the true God. This message of repentance is just as important for America today.
